Have you heard of the 3/50 Project? Small towns have been saved by similar initiatives where local people commit to buying some percentage of their goods locally vs. buying online, or even driving to adjacent municipalities such as Ashwaubenon, Appleton or even Chicago!

Project 3/50 encourages us to find and support 3 Independent 'brick and mortar' businesses we don't want to lose, and commit to spending \$50 combined at those 3 businesses. While Independent businesses do put more dollars back into our local economy, it is a detriment to MacArthur Heights neighborhood to have ANY storefronts vacant – maybe even especially our bigger buildings. This was reinforced to me when Hancock Fabric moved to Ashwaubenon. 



ABOVE: Aldermanic District 11 is dark gray. MacArthur Heights Association is outlined in the southwest corner of District 11.




ABOVE: Brown County District 10 and District 11 within the Association boundaries. MacArthur Heights Neighborhood boundaries are outlined.



PARKS DEPARTMENT APPROVES BUDGET TO IMPROVE BEAVER DAM BASEBALL FIELD #2

Baseball/softball fields 1 & 2 in Beaver Dam Park have drainage issues. In addition, Field 1 is a 'short' field -sized below standard.

Budget is approved to move Field 2 slightly North and East, redevelop the field to improve drainage, install new infield fencing, and an asphalt path to make it fully accessible.

In Fall 2014 lighting will finish Field 2. Field 1 redevelopment does not yet have budget approval, but the larger plan is to turn it to be in a cloverleaf design. Down the road, a small concessions building & toilet facility is planned as well.

Field 3 is in good condition and no changes are planned.

UPDATE ON WOOD STREET CONSTRUCTION

Contractors will begin working on curb & gutter adjustment within the next week or so [of Aug 9, 2013.]

Following mud jacking, spot replacement of curb and gutter will be completed. Approximately one week behind spot replacement, the contractor will begin excavation and street resurfacing.

In all, I would anticipate the Wood Lane work to run from mid-August through the end of September.
