Bay Beach is the 9th oldest continuously operating amusement park in the United States, and is tied for 21st oldest in the world.

The addition of the restored Zippin Pippin in 2011 (the 4th oldest wooden roller coaster in the world) is our gateway to the park's future growth, building on our rich 120 year history.

Bay Beach Amusement Park offers 18 rides and a variety of fun activities for the entire family!

Tickets: Ride tickets cost 25 cents each. Rides require 1, 2 or 4 tickets. Pony ride tickets are \$2.00 and can be purchased next to the ponies.

The Sanctuary is a unique 700-acre urban wildlife refuge that supports a free flying flock of native ducks and geese. Corn is sold to feed the waterfowl. Nesting bald eagles, egrets, herons and other birds can be observed.

The **Nature Education Center** offers many hands-on educational exhibits for people of all ages: The Habitat House, Habitat Hollow, and crawl through Habitat Hole.

The **Floating Boardwalk** was constructed as a unique "walk-on water" experience for the public, as a short cut, connecting the Nature Center to the **Observation Building** area.

The **Resch Conservation Wing** is the place to visit for watching waterfowl, seeing live song and shore-birds and having the chance to touch live animals at the Critter Counter.

The **Resch Falls** was dedicated in the summer of 2010, rises 25 feet above the lagoon surface. Over 3,500 gallons of water per minute cascades off of the massive dolomite stone ledges.

The **Woodland Building** houses indoor nocturnal animal exhibits. Flying squirrels, owls, mink and various other nighttime creatures can be seen in their darkened environment.

The **Environmental Education Program** serves schools, organizations and the general public with nature programs for all ages. Call for further info.


