The Brown County Housing Authority (BCHA) is pleased to announce that Senior Homes Inc. has been selected to participate in the BCHA Project Based Voucher Program. The Project Based Vouchers will provide a housing subsidy in eight (8) one-bedroom units at Parkside Apartments in Pulaski, WI. These units will be made available for qualifying low income elderly or disabled families or individuals. The provision of these vouchers helps to achieve the BCHA goal of de-concentrating poverty and expanding economic and housing opportunities for low income families in rural areas of Brown County, Wisconsin.

The BCHA will continue to accept proposals on an on-going basis from property owners and developers interested in placing Project-Based Vouchers (PBV) in developments in rural areas of Brown County. The BCHA anticipates awarding up to approximately 30 Project-Based Vouchers.
