

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The City of Green Bay, Wisconsin has adopted an Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development covering federal fiscal year 2016. Notice is being provided to the public with a posting of The Redevelopment Authority agenda dated October 20, 2016, that a substantial amendment will be made to this plan to reprogram \$300,000 of Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund Program Income to a new eligible Historic Preservation activity with a national objective of Slum and Blight Spot Basis Elimination. This amendment will reduce the amount of Economic Development Funding available for job creation and increase the amount of funding needed to preserve a blighted, but historically significant, building in downtown Green Bay, which in turn, increases the feasibility of a private entity reusing it for commercial purposes.
