1026 Harvey St. Fire

At 5am this morning, the Green Bay Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 1026 Harvey Street. Responding crews encountered heavy fire from the front of the upper/lower duplex. All occupants were evacuated prior to our arrival including one child that was pulled through a bedroom window by a Green Bay Police Officer. The fire was knocked down relatively quick upon entry.

Four individuals were transported to a local hospital. Two of those individuals have since been transferred to a Milwaukee burn center. The victims' conditions are not known at this time.

The Green Bay Fire Marshals Office, the Brown County Investigation Task Force, and the State Fire Marshals Office will be investigating the cause and origin of this fire.
