At 2 pm this afternoon, the Green Bay Fire Department responded to a report of a porch in the rear of a duplex that was on fire. Fire department personnel were training in full gear just blocks away when the call came in, which minimized response time. When crews arrived they found a large amount of fire in the rear of the duplex. Fire had also extended into the attic area and into the interior of the duplex. Fire extinguishment took an estimated 10 minutes.

Occupants were home at the time of the fire and a neighbor knocked on their door to let them know to evacuate. No one was injured during this fire and the Green Bay Fire Marshal's Office is currently investigating the cause of this fire. Damages are estimated in excess of \$50,000. The American Red Cross is assisting two adults and three children in finding shelter this evening. The Green Bay Police Department and the Department of Public Works assisted during this incident.
