1322 S. Broadway Fire

Yesterday at 1:50PM, the Green Bay Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 1322 S. Broadway. Arriving crews observed smoke coming from the second floor of an upper/lower apartment building. Fire crews made entry and quickly extinguished the fire.

All occupants of the building had evacuated prior to our arrival including one person that had jumped from the second story apartment. He was transported to St. Vincent Hospital and as of this morning is still under their care. The extent of his injuries are unknown.

The Brown County Fire Investigation Task Force assisted the Green Bay Fire Marshals Office in the investigation. The fire started in the kitchen. The cause of this fire is still under investigation. Most of the damage from the fire was contained to the upper apartment and damages are estimated at \$50,000.

A total of seven people were displaced as a result of this fire. The American Red Cross assisted in finding shelter last night for all involved. All occupants will be displaced for an unknown amount of time.
