

## Local Business Spotlight!



Dear Joannes Neighborhood:

It is with great pleasure to announce that the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual City Stadium Run/walk for Veterans will take place on the streets of Joannes Neighborhood on the morning of September 6<sup>th</sup>. The run/walk will start at 8:00 am near the corner of E. Walnut and Baird (East High School) and continue south on Baird to Emily Street. The runners/walkers will then head east on Emily and pick up the East River Trail in East Lawn Park and head north. Exiting East Lawn Park at Goodell St., the participants will continue to head north on Goodell to Chicago St. by Meyer Park. Re-entering the East River Trail, the City Stadium Route will continue behind Joannes Park and then connect with the Cora Vandenperren Trail which will bring the participants back to Baird St. Runners/walkers will then head south on Baird, enter the City Stadium parking lot, enter City Stadium and finish on the 50 yard of City Stadium. The number one comment I receive from our participants is how "beautiful" the course is by including the neighborhood parks and trails. A lot of the participants had no idea these parks and trails exist in the Joannes Neighborhood so this event had been a great way to showcase this hidden green jewel which is one of my goals in organizing this event.

The other two goals associated with the event is to showcase City Stadium (home of the Green Bay Packers from 1925-1956) and to raise money and awareness for our veterans. I'm please to say in the first two years of our event we have raised over \$18,900 for our veterans. This year our proceeds will benefit the Wounded Warrior Amputee Football team. Three members of the Warrior Football team are from Wisconsin and will be joining us on September 6 along with our special guest, Green Bay Packer legend, Jerry Kramer. Please come out and join us on September 6 to meet our wonderful warriors and Mr. Kramer. Radio host John Maino will start the event off at approximately 7:40 am in Joannes Park by introducing our warriors and special guest and allowing them to say a few words crowd. Mayor Schmitt will officially start the race at 8:00 am and then at approximately 9:10 am, three skydivers will drop from the sky with the American flag to Lee Greenwood's song "Proud to be an American" and land in City Stadium. There usually isn't a dry eye in the stadium at this moment.

So please find time to join us on September 6. If you live by the route, please come out and cheer and offer words of encouragement for our runners/walkers. ## James Duane Doty "Doty Street"

(Nov. 1799- June 1865)

Land Speculator, Lawyer/Politician, one of the men who  
founded Wisconsin Territory. (ie1836)

Since I live on Doty Street here in Joannes Park NA I wanted to start looking into where our street names came from. James Duane Doty was born in Salem, New York on Nov 5, 1799. Fast forward to 1818 and Mr. Doty moved to Detroit which was the capital of the Michigan Territory at the time. That same year he became an apprentice Lawyer under Charles Larned and entered the Bar in Wayne County. He practiced law for a year. In 1819 Doty was appointed Clerk of Court to the Michigan Territory. In June 1820 he resigned in order to be the Secretary of the Lewis/Cass expedition which was a summer-long exploration of the Michigan Territory west to the head waters of the Mississippi River. After the expedition was over he moved back to Detroit to resume his legal practice. In the winter 1822 Doty traveled to Washington DC where, with sponsorship of Henry Wheaton, was admitted to practice before the Supreme Court.

In 1823 the federal judicial district for northern and western Michigan Territory was started which is now the State of Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. Doty was appointed as the federal judge by President James Monroe. Before taking his new duties in April he married Sarah Collins in Whitesboro, New York. Due to his work requirements he had to live in the district Doty moved his wife from Detroit to Prairie du Chien in 1823. He held court in Prairie du Chien (PdC), Green Bay and Mackinac. While living in PdC was the first Postmaster from 1823 to 1824. Doty then in 1824 moved to Green Bay to be centered in the district where he lived until 1841. He was replaced by David Irvin as district judge in 1832.

Following this, Doty served as a member of the Michigan Territorial Council from 1834 to 1835 in the western part of the territory. He argued for the creation of a new territorial government for Wisconsin, sending a petitions to Congress in favor of splitting Michigan Territory into two parts. One east and one west of Lake Michigan. Doty was in support of this was early as 1824. He felt that the growing number of settlers in Wisconsin were not adequately provided for by the territorial government in Detroit because the distance from the city and the settlement of Wisconsin. Doty claimed also that votes sent by residents west of Lake Michigan could not be sent in time to be counted and residents of Lower Michigan cared little about the affairs west of the lake. In 1835 Doty wishes were.....to be continued!

## From the JPNA Kitchen

### “Crock Pot Lasagna”

1 pound ground beef  
Lasagna noodles  
1 jar spaghetti sauce  
1 1/2 cups cottage cheese  
1 1/2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese  
2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese

Brown ground beef and drain. Spoon 1 cup spaghetti sauce in bottom of 4 quart crockpot. Mix remaining sauce with beef. Place 2 uncooked lasagna noodles on sauce in crockpot. Spread 1/3 meat mixture on top of noodles. Spread 3/4 cup cottage cheese over meat. Sprinkle 1/2 cup mozzarella cheese over cottage cheese. Add another layer of uncooked noodles, 1/3 meat mixture, the remaining cottage cheese and 1/2 cup mozzarella cheese. Place another layer of uncooked noodles meat mixture and mozzarella cheese. Sprinkle parmesan cheese over top. Cook on low for 4 hours. If cooked much longer, it gets a bit well done.
