

A CHARTER ORDINANCE¹²
CREATING SECTION 1.02(4) OF THE
CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF GREEN BAY BY ESTABLISHING
THE OFFICE OF COUNCIL VICE PRESIDENT

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created Section 1.02(4) of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Green Bay which shall read as follows:

1.02(4) COUNCIL PRESIDENT. The Council shall, at its regular meeting on the third Tuesday of April, elect from its members a Vice President for a term of two years. The Vice President, in the absence of the Mayor and President, shall preside at meetings of the Council, and during the absence or inability of the Mayor and President, shall have the powers and duties of the Mayor and President, except that he shall not have the power to approve an act of the Council which the Mayor or President has disapproved by filing an objection with the Clerk. He shall, when so officiating, be styled "Acting Mayor."

SECTION 2. This is a charter ordinance and shall not take effect until 60 days after its passage and publication.
