

A CHARTER ORDINANCE<sup>7</sup>  
WHEREBY THE CITY OF GREEN BAY ELECTS NOT  
TO BE GOVERNED BY THE PROVISIONS OF  
SECTION 62.23(1) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES  
(CITY PLAN COMMISSION)

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Green Bay hereby elects, pursuant to Section 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, not to be governed by Section 62.23(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and hereby ordains that membership of the City Plan Commission shall be as follows:

The City Plan  
Commission shall consist of seven members: The president of the Park Board, the City Engineer-Superintendent, an alderman, and four citizens. Citizen members shall be persons of recognized experience and qualifications.

The alderman member of  
the Commission shall be elected by a two-thirds vote of the Council in April in each year.

The four citizen members  
shall be appointed by the Mayor. The first terms shall be staggered, one for one year, two for two years, and one for three years, respectively, from the succeeding first day of May. Thereafter annually, during April, members shall be appointed for a term of three years.

The City Plan  
Commission shall have power and authority to employ experts and a staff, and to pay for their services, and such other expenses as may be necessary and proper, not exceeding, in all, the appropriation that may be made for such Commission by the legislative body, or placed at its disposal through gift, and subject to any ordinance or resolution enacted by the governing body.

SECTION 2. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall not take effect until 60 days after its passage and publication.
