

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 6-11

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTIONS 29.506(4)(a) & (b)4.,
GREEN BAY MUNICIPAL CODE,
RELATING TO NAUTICAL TRAFFIC
SPEED LIMITS ON FOX RIVER

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN BAY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 29.506(4)(a), Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended as follows:

(4) 15 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON THE FOX RIVER.

(a) Except as stated in this section, all nautical traffic on the Fox River, as it passes through the City of Green Bay, shall travel no faster than 15 mph; ~~exceptions below notwithstanding~~. This area shall be specifically described as from the mouth of the Green Bay up river to 3,810 feet south of the railroad bridge at Porlier Street within the riparian boundaries of the City of Green Bay.

SECTION 2. Section 29.506(4)(b)4., Green Bay Municipal Code, is hereby amended as follows:

(b) Exception. Nautical traffic shall travel at slow-no-wake speed on the entire length of the Fox River within Green Bay from sunset to sunrise (nighttime hours). Nautical traffic shall also travel at slow-no-wake speed throughout the following areas at all times:

4. ~~1,525 feet north of the Mason Street (Tilleman) Bridge~~ **Walnut Street** Bridge to 500 feet north of the Mason Street (Tilleman) Bridge as marked by control buoys or signs.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.
