Beth welcomed the neighbors, Mayor Jim Schmitt, The Mayor's Chief of Staff, Andy Rosendahl, and Kevin King from the City of Green Bay, Neighborhood Department.

Mayor Schmitt spoke on the importance of neighborhood associations, the importance of good trails, schools, parks and jobs in the city of Green Bay. He spoke briefly about the monthly leadership council meetings held with the presidents of each neighborhood association.

Kevin King explained how neighborhood associations work, including the 40 associations in the city of Green Bay. We are given \$1,000 per year to operate. One meeting for the entire neighborhood invited a year will be held. One newsletter a year will go out to the entire neighborhood. Neighborhoods should raise ¼ of \$1,000.00.

Board members reported on the planting recently done surrounding the Maple Arches Neighborhood Association sign on Shawano Ave. Planting was done by the MANA board members.
