

Keeping Kids Safe This Summer

To make sure that your children stay, Kid Safe Worldwide recommends that children:

- always cross the street with an Adult until age 10
- cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks
- look left, right and left again when crossing
- always walk, never run, when crossing streets
- walk on sidewalks and paths
- walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible if there are no sidewalks
- never run out into the street or cross in between parked cars
- Wear a properly fitting helmet when riding a bicycle or play wheeled sports
- are never left alone in vehicles

Learning in Retirement (LIR)

LIR is a peer-led group offering non-credit educational enrichment classes to retired and/or semi-retired adults who enjoy learning for the sake of learning.

LIR is run by volunteers and has about 900 members, most of them 50 and over.

Classes are offered on a wide variety of topics and formats, including lectures, discussions, hands-on, arts, crafts, and technology classes, and even some moderate exercise courses. Classes offered range in everything from Art to Zumba. For example, History, Travel, Nature, Yoga, Cooking, Music, Painting, Games, Religion, Foreign Languages, poetry, Computers, Health, and many more all taught by volunteer instructors.

Classes usually meet once a week for 2 hours. Most classes meet from 1 to 4 weeks. Many classes are held at UWGB. Others meet at convenient off campus sites like the Neville Public Museum.

Annual membership runs from September to August for one small fee. For that membership as many classes as you like can be taken. A UWGB parking permit is included in the fee. There is also the opportunity to register for any of LIR Day Trips, some of which do have a small additional fee. There are invitations to all LIR Social Events, Fall and Spring Catalogs, and the LIR Newsletter. Access to the free LIR Lending Library and DVDs.

Why join LIR? To stay mentally active, learn something new, create something, exercise, meet new friends, take unique daytrips.
