Lifeguard Training

Begins June 24 and runs Monday-Friday through July 5 from 9:00 a.m.-12:15 p.m. (no class July 4) at Colburn Pool.

This class will certify you as a lifeguard through the American Red Cross. Students must be 15 years of age by the first class date and should have Level 5 swimming skills.

Cost of the course for Green Bay residents is \$140.00 (includes books). A portion of this fee will be refunded to the student if they work a set number of hours for the Green Bay Aquatics Program. A \$50.00 non-resident fee will be charged if applicable.








Green Bay street trees provide millions of dollars of environmental, economic and aesthetic benefits to the community. Over their lifetime, street tree benefits exceed the costs of planting and care, representing a 300 percent return on investment. Tree benefits increase over time highlighting the importance of not only planting trees, but of providing ongoing maintenance and protection. These benefits are a reminder of the worthwhile investment in our community forestry program.
