LOUD RADIO/STEREO FROM A VEHICLE COMPLAINT FORM

Wisconsin State Statute 346.94 (16) (a) Radios or other electric sound amplification devices.

"No person may operate or park, stop or leave standing a motor vehicle while using a radio or other electric sound amplification device emitting sound from the vehicle that is audible under normal conditions from a distance of 75 or more feet, unless the electric sound amplification device is being used to request assistance or warn against an unsafe condition."

Wisconsin State Statute 346.945 Vehicle owner's liability for radios or other electric sound amplification devices.

(1) *The owner of a vehicle is liable for the violation.*

(2) *Any member of the public who observes a violation of s.346.94(16) may prepare a written report indicating that a violation has occurred.*

(3) *Within 24 hours after observing the violation, a member of the public may deliver a report containing all of the information below to the Police Department of the municipality in which the violation occurred.*
