**1. Consent Agenda**

The meeting of October 3, 2013 was called to order at 5:34 pm. Minutes of September 5, 2013 and a current financial report were approved with a motion made by Scott Vanidestine of Wilder Park Association and seconded by Dan Theno of Oak Grove Association. Motion carried.

**2. Mayor's Report**

Mayor Jim Schmitt spoke about a possible bridge presentation to showcase at the Neville Museum and that he was finishing up with the 2013 City Budget to be completed this month.

**3. Bulk Item Pick-Up and Leaf Collection**

Director of Public Works, Steve Grenier, spoke about leaf collection beginning on October 14<sup>th</sup> through November 17<sup>th</sup> and brush collection is currently taking place through October 14<sup>th</sup>. It was also stated that by July 1<sup>st</sup> garbage collection will be completely automated in Green Bay. Informational literature regarding bulk item pick-up, bulk item drop off center locations and hours of operation, and maps of the garbage collection routes on specific days was said to be going out before our next GBNLC meeting in November. The new 96 gallon garbage cans will be delivered prior to the beginning of automated garbage collection. The \$60 cost will be

rolled on to resident's property taxes. Steve Grenier also gave a quick update regarding the Leo Frigo Bridge. An extensive analysis has been done on the bridge but it is still too soon to tell when restoration will be finished.

#### 4. Reporting Property Complaints

The Housing/Zoning division is responsible for questions regarding City ordinances relating to land use, setback requirements, sign permitting, parking requirements on private property, and floodplain determinations. They address complaints concerning housing condition, simple building code violations, improper disposal of waste material, litter, and rubbish problems.
