

You may have heard that the City of Green Bay is recommending stray animals found within its limits go to Packerland Veterinary Center instead of the Bay Area Humane Society. This decision was not made lightly. In fact, the City of Green Bay issued a standard Request for Proposals from any entities that were interested in providing animal services. It is in the best interests of the City to show, in a very transparent manner, why City staff has recommended a new animal services provider.

## SUMMARY OF PURCHASING SCORES

The evaluation team scored each provider based on objective criteria. Below you will find the information that the evaluation team used to score Packerland V.C. and Bay Area H.S.

- Pricing was weighted at 40% of the total score. If Packerland would have bid \$20,000 higher than BAHS, it would have still secured the committee’s recommendation because the remaining 60% of the total score, based on staffing, hours, and facility, was so significantly favorable to Packerland. Price is a factor, but it is not the only reason.
