The meeting was called to order by Renee Keehan.

1. **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

Motion made by Renee Keehan to approve the May 8, 2013 Minutes, seconded by Kathy De Cremer. All in favor. Motion carried.

2. **APPEALS**

- a. Appeal of Anthony Lowe requesting to move to 535-1/2 10th Ave.

Anthony appeared in person. Renee Keehan advised Anthony of his right to discuss treatment issues in closed session and informed him not to use the names of the victims.

Anthony currently lives in Manitowoc, Wisconsin. He would like to move to Green Bay to live with his girlfriend and her daughters. His girlfriend has health issues.

Anthony was charged with 2nd degree sexual assault in 2003 in Manitowoc County. The victim was age 14. Anthony served one year in prison and had five years probation. He is no longer under supervision with the Department of Corrections for this offense. Paperwork submitted indicated Anthony did not need sex offender treatment.

A motion to DENY the appeal of Anthony Lowe was made by Heidi Michel, seconded by Ben Heiman. Heidi Michel feels Anthony should live in Manitowoc County because that is where the offense occurred.

All in favor. Motion carried.

- b. Appeal of Estella M. Iddings requesting to move to 1909 Preble Ave.

Estella failed to appear.

A motion to DENY the appeal of Estella M. Iddings was made by Ben Heiman, seconded by Kathy De Cremer. All in favor. Motion carried.

- c. Appeal of Dale R. McGillivray requesting to move to 316 James St., Apt. 3

Dale appeared in person. Renee Keehan advised Dale of his right to discuss treatment issues in closed session and informed him not to use the names of the victims.

Dale appeared before the board in 2009 and 2011. He was approved to live at both locations. The board agreed they did not need to hear details about the offense again.

Dale was charged with 2nd degree sexual assault in 1995 in Brown County. The victim was age 15. Dale served 5 years and 11 months in prison. He is currently under supervision with the Department of Corrections. Dale has had serious health problems and most recently had surgery for his heart condition.

A motion to APPROVE the appeal of Dale R. McGillivray was made by Ben Heiman, seconded by Renee Keehan. Three in favor. One opposed (Heidi Michel). Motion carried.

3. **NEXT MEETING DATE**

The next meeting date of July 10, 2013 was confirmed.
