1. Approval of the minutes from the September 16, 2013 Traffic Commission meeting.

INITIAL REQUESTS

2. Request by Ald. Thomas De Wane to establish a 4-WAY STOP condition at Deckner Avenue and Danz Avenue. **(Alds. De Wane and Kocha – Dist 2 and 5)**
3. Request by Ald. Thomas De Wane to establish a 4-WAY STOP condition at Newberry Avenue and Wesley Avenue. **(Ald. Kocha – Dist 5)**
4. Request by Preble High School to modify the parking restrictions on Deckner Avenue just east of Danz Avenue. **(Alds. De Wane and Kocha – Dist 2 and 5)**
5. Request by Ald. Tim De Wane to remove the 2-HOUR PARKING zone on the west side of the 1000 block of South Roosevelt Street. **(Ald. De Wane – Dist 4)**
6. Request by Ald. Kocha to discuss modifying the parking restrictions on the east side of the 300 block of Victoria Street. **(Ald. Kocha – Dist 5)**

9. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO STOPPING OR STANDING 10 PM TO 3 AM SATURDAY AND SUNDAY zone on the east side of South Broadway from 3rd Street to a point 325 feet north of 3rd Street.
10. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING TAXI LOADING ONLY 12 AM TO 3 AM SATURDAY AND SUNDAY zone on the east side of Washington Street from a point 100 feet south of Doty Street to Doty Street.
