GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Approval of the *amended* minutes from the August 18, 2014, Traffic Commission meeting.

INITIAL REQUESTS

2. Request by Ald. Tim De Wane to remove the 2-HOUR PARKING zone on the north side of Eliza Street from Clay Street to Roosevelt Street. **(Ald. Tim De Wane – District 4)**
3. Request by Ald. Scannell to establish a NO PARKING zone on one side of Chestnut Street north of Mather Street. **(Ald. Scannell – District 7)**
4. Request by Jackson Elementary School to modify the on-street parking zones on the south side of Ninth Street next to the school to allow loading and unloading of students. **(Ald. Wery – District 8)**

REFERRED BACK FROM COUNCIL

5. Request by Ald. Kocha to discuss, with possible action, removal of the NO PARKING TO CORNER signs on the northwest corner of Mills Street and Henry Street, to make parking on both streets legal on that corner, in order to accommodate a new business. (Referred back to the Traffic Commission at the August 19, 2014 Common Council meeting) **(Ald. Nennig – District 5)**

6. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the 2-WAY YIELD condition on Louise Street at Heyrman Street.
7. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a 2-WAY STOP condition on Louise Street at Heyrman Street.
8. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the south side of Voyager Drive from a point 335 feet west of Goddard Way to Goddard Way.
9. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the west side of Goddard Way from a point 145 feet south of Voyager Drive to Voyager Drive.

10. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the 2-HOUR METERED PARKING zone on the south side of Howe Street from Madison Street to a point 43 feet west of Monroe Avenue.
11. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the NO PARKING zone the south side of Howe Street from a point 43 feet west of Monroe Avenue to Monroe Avenue.
12. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the 2-HOUR METERED PARKING zone on the north side of Moravian Street from Madison Street to Monroe Avenue.
13. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a 2-HOUR 7 AM TO 6 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY parking zone on the south side of Howe Street from a point 40 feet east of Madison Street to a point 43 feet west of Monroe Avenue.
14. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the south side of Howe Street from Madison Street to a point 40 feet east of Madison Street.
15. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a 2-HOUR 7 AM TO 6 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY parking zone on the north side of Moravian Street from a point 55 feet east of Madison Street to a point 50 feet west of Monroe Avenue.
16. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the north side of Moravian Street from Madison Street to a point 55 feet east of Madison Street.
17. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the north side of Moravian Street from a point 50 feet west of Monroe Avenue to Monroe Avenue
18. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the NO PARKING zone on the east side of Washington Street from a point 75 feet south of Walnut Street to a point 110 feet north of Pine Street.
19. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the NO PARKING zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 37 feet south of Walnut Street to a point 60 feet north of Cherry Street.
20. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the east side of Washington Street from a point 140 feet south of Cherry Street to a point 110 feet north of Pine Street.
21. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the east side of Washington Street from a point 75 feet south of Walnut Street to a point 50 feet north of Walnut Street.
22. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 40 feet south of Walnut Street to a point 190 feet north of Walnut Street.
23. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 50 feet south of Cherry Street to a point 60 feet north of Cherry Street.

24. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a METERED PARKING zone on the east side of Washington St from a point 50 feet north of Walnut Street to a point 140 south of Cherry Street.
25. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a PARKING REGULATED BY POSTED SIGN (RESERVED 1-HOUR NICOLET BANK OFFICE CUSTOMERS ONLY 7 AM TO 6 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY) zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 190 feet north of Walnut Street to a point 50 feet south of Cherry Street.
26. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the 15-MINUTE LOADING ONLY DAILY zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 30 feet north of Pine Street to a point 190 feet north of Pine Street.
27. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the NO PARKING zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 190 feet north of Pine Street to Main Street.
28. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO STOPPING OR STANDING LOADING ONLY 7 AM TO 7 PM DAILY zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 30 feet north of Pine Street to a point 110 feet north of Pine Street.
29. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a METERED PARKING zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 110 feet north of Pine Street to a point 115 feet south of CityDeck Court.
30. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the west side of Washington Street from a point 115 feet south of CityDeck Court to Main Street.
