Film Green Bay is excited to announce the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Green Bay Film Festival with exciting new changes! The film festival schedule and films have been posted at <http://www.gbfilmfestival.org>

The Festival this year is partnering with St. Norbert College bringing you a new venue with a more “theatrical” experience viewing films. The venues are located in several buildings on the campus just a building or two apart. All the venues are within minutes to walk, but should you like to take a ride, the Green Bay Metro is providing bus service.

The Festival also starts early this year, beginning with a Thursday night event at the Cassandra Voss Center on March 3 at 7pm. Sharing their vision of Social Justice and Human Interest, the Festival will show the film: “30 Seconds Away: Breaking the Cycle.” A discussion about the split second decision that creates the situation of homelessness will follow with a special panel including the director, producer and several key members involved with producing this film.

The Festival has also included films Friday afternoon at 1:00 & 3:30 pm prior to the traditional Opening Night Film & Party beginning at 7pm.
