1. Roll Call.

Ald. Wery, Ald. Tim De Wane, Ald. Steuer and Ald. Scannell were present.

2. Approval of the Agenda.

A motion was made by Ald. Scannell and seconded by Ald. Tim De Wane to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

3. Approval of the minutes from the April 13, 2015 meeting.

A motion was made by Ald. Scannell and seconded by Ald. Steuer to approve the minutes from the April 13, 2015 meeting. Motion carried.

4. Application for a Class "C" Wine License by Timothy Cleary at 1247 Velp Avenue. (Currently has beer only.)

The City Attorney's Office and Green Bay Police Department (GBPD) had no objections.

A motion was made by Ald. Steuer and seconded by Ald. Scannell to approve the application for a Class "C" Wine License by Timothy Cleary at 1247 Velp Avenue, with the approval of the proper authorities. (Currently has beer only.) Motion carried.

5. Application for one of seven available "Class B" Combination License by The Cannery Market, LLC at 320 N. Broadway.

The City Attorney's Office and Green Bay Police Department (GBPD) had no objections.

A motion was made by Ald. Tim De Wane and seconded by Ald. Scannell to approve the application for one of seven available "Class B" Combination License by The Cannery Market, LLC at 320 N. Broadway, with the approval of the proper authorities. Motion carried.

6. Request by the owner of Brewski's on Broadway, 1100 S. Broadway, to hold an outdoor event on June 27.

The City Attorney's Office and Green Bay Police Department (GBPD) had no objections.

Ald. Wery opened the floor without objection.

Randy Trembl, 1100 S. Broadway, appeared and informed the Committee the area for this event will be fenced in and security will check identification.

Ald. Wery returned to regular order of business.

A motion was made by Ald. Scannell and seconded by Ald. Tim De Wane to approve the request by the owner of Brewski's on Broadway, 1100 S. Broadway, to hold an outdoor event on June 27. The approval of the request is subject to complaint. Motion carried.

7. Appeal by Rachel E. Anker to the denial of her Operator License application.

Atty. Leigl stated that Ms. Anker's appeal was listed on the April 13 agenda; however she contacted him and stated she never received the notice to appear, therefore the Common Council referred this item back to the Committee. The City Attorney's Office still recommends denial due to Ms. Anker's felonies for manufacturing and delivering THC and maintaining a drug trafficking place, and opined that these convictions substantially relate to the licensing activity.

Nobody appeared for this item.

Ald. Steuer stated he would like to speak with Ms. Anker before making a decision.

Atty. Leigl stated he spoke with Ms. Anker regarding tonight's meeting, and left a voice message for her to appear. A copy of the agenda was also mailed to Ms. Anker.

Ald. Scannell reminded the Committee that according to the State law, we cannot issue a license to an individual who has a felony that substantially relates to the licensed activity. Ald. Scannell stated if enough time has passed since the last offense, the license could be approved but clearly Ms. Anker's record is very recent.

Capt. Warych stated the GBPD also recommends denial.

A motion was made by Ald. Scannell and seconded by Ald. Tim De Wane to deny the appeal by Rachel E. Anker to the denial of her Operator License application. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ald. Scannell and seconded by Ald. Steuer to adjourn the meeting at 5:11 p.m. Motion carried.

For all licensing issues, the Committee may potentially convene in closed session pursuant to §19.85 (1)(b) and/or §19.85 (1)(f) Wisconsin Statutes, for the purpose of considering information with respect to licensing for a person. The applicant has the right to demand that the meeting be held in open session. The applicant may also request that the meeting be held in closed session. The Committee may, thereafter, reconvene in open session pursuant to §19.85(2) Wisconsin Statutes to report any actions taken during the closed session and to consider all other matters on the agenda.
