Green Bay Public Arts Commission Awards Grant

The Green Bay Public Arts Commission determined at their last meeting to award their first grant recipient from their Annual Grants Program. The award totals \$1,500, which will be used to help create public art opportunities for the Green Bay community.

The recipient is Brandon Rockstroh, Director of Choral Music at Southwest High School. Brandon Rockstroh is a graduate of Ashwaubenon High School, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, and is a current resident of Green Bay.
