### **Green Bay Proposed Downtown Historic District**

(Green Bay, WI) Green Bay's Office of Economic Development, in conjunction with the City's Historic Preservation Commission, are hosting an informational meeting aimed at exploring the possibility of nominating an east side Downtown Historic District to the National Register of Historic Places. Speakers will include Mayor Schmitt, Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer Daina Penkiunas, and Director of Economic Development Kevin Vonck.
