(Green Bay, WI)– The Lucky Llama will walk again across the Main Street bridge in Green Bay, starting at 8:40 pm on December 31, 2017. Legend has it that anyone who sees the Lucky Llama cross the bridge will have good luck the whole year through! This year, the City of Green Bay has added to the fun by hosting a sign contest, judged by Mayor Schmitt. The person holding the most creative Lucky Llama sign will receive a prize which will be awarded following the Lucky Llama’s stroll down “Lucky Llama Lane.” A fireworks display by Spielbauer, sponsored by U.S. Bank, will conclude the festivities.

Free parking is available throughout the downtown, but is encouraged in the Main Street ramp. The Llama will cross from the west side of the bridge, near the Neville Museum, to the east side of the bridge, near the Hampton Inn.

US Bank Eve is filled with old-fashioned events for ages 1 to 101. Events include: family games and activities at the East Side, West Side and Ferguson Family YMCAs; ice skating at Cornerstone Rink in De Pere; family activities and a dance for seniors at the Kroc Center; teen night at the Ferguson Family YMCA; exhibits, Lucky Llama-themed activities and prizes at the Neville Museum; and horse-drawn wagon rides downtown.
