GREEN BAY METRO ANNOUNCES QUANTUM PRESENTATION WITH Q'STRAIT Cutting edge rear-facing mobility securement system to be showcased.

GREEN BAY, WISCONSIN, (May 9, 2016) – Green Bay Metro has partnered with [Q'Strait](#) to host an open house presentation and demonstration of [QUANTUM](#), the transportation industry's first fully automatic **rear-facing securement system**. QUANTUM enables wheelchair and scooter passengers to secure themselves with the simple push of a button and without requiring driver assistance – all in under 25 seconds.

With community support, Green Bay Metro will begin a cost-free trial to introduce the technology on future fixed-route buses. Along with Eau Claire, WI, who rolled out the **QUANTUM** 18 months ago with great success, Green Bay Metro will become one of the first 10 public transit properties in the United States to move forward with the innovative technology. The feedback thus far has been very positive.

We anticipate reduced liability for the city, faster boarding and de-boarding of mobility devices on fixed route transit buses and independence for the rider in mobility devices as they can self-secure most mobility devices with the touch of a button."
