

**MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order by Dean Gerondale.

**1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Approval of the December 13, 2017 Minutes of the Sex Offender Residency Board meeting

Motion made by R. Keehan to approve the December 13, 2017 Minutes, seconded by K. De Cremer. All in favor. Motion carried.

**2. APPEALS**

(a) Appeal of Christopher Jamroz requesting to move to 915 S. Chestnut Avenue, Unit A

Christopher appeared in person. D. Gerondale advised Christopher of his right to discuss treatment issues in closed session and informed him not to use the names of the victims.

Christopher appeared before the board in October and was approved at this location for 90 days. He is to provide documentation showing he's in aftercare.

Christopher graduated AODA and provided the certificate. He also received his driver's safety plan in the mail. He provided a letter of recommendation from the ATTIC. He's attended six group sessions out of sixteen thus far.

Christopher read from his written safety plan. He discussed his triggers and how to deal with them. He is occasionally tested for drugs and alcohol use and always comes back clean. Christopher enjoys weight lifting and spends a lot of time at the gym. He spent the holidays with family and friends. Christopher is trying to build positive relationships.

At first his neighbors were worried about him living here, but he recently found out from his landlord that some have called to say he is a good tenant and he wants them to learn he is a good person.

Christopher's roofing business is going well and he has improved his credit score.

A motion to APPROVE the appeal of Christopher Jamroz, address specific, was made by R. Keehan, seconded by K. De Cremer. All in favor. Motion carried.

(b) Appeal of Harold Treadway requesting to move to 1730 Badger Street, #7

Harold appeared in person. D. Gerondale advised Harold of his right to discuss treatment issues in closed session and informed him not to use the names of the victims.

Harold appeared before the board in December and was approved at this location for 30 days.

Harold provided documentation from the Department of Corrections regarding completion of the ATR program. He is still employed at American Foods, working third shift in shipping. When not working, he plays video games or spends time with his mom or girlfriend. He does not own a smartphone and does not go on the Internet.

Harold is still in aftercare with James Drake. He provided a detailed letter last month. He probably has two to three years left with Mr. Drake.

D. Gerondale noted that one recommendation was that Harold stay away from isolationism. To stay active, Harold stated he works six days a week and he spends most Sundays with his girlfriend or mother. He is involved in a social group and would like to join an adult's only bowling league this summer. He spent time with his mom on Christmas and texted friends to wish them a Merry Christmas. He might be able to volunteer at Paul's Pantry. Harold will be off GPS once approved. R. Keehan encouraged Harold to stay involved in the community.

A motion to approve the appeal of Harold Treadway, address specific, was made by K. De Cremer, seconded by R. Keehan.

Discussion: D. Gerondale would like to have Harold come back in 90 days to see how he continues to improve with Jim Drake, his job, and avoiding isolation.

None in favor of the motion. Motion failed.

A motion to APPROVE the appeal of Harold Treadway, address specific, for a period of 90 days, was made by D. Gerondale, seconded by K. De Cremer. All in favor. Motion carried.

(c) Appeal of Jeffrey Cox requesting to move to 301 S. Van Buren Street

Jeffrey did not appear, as his parole officer asked that he be put on the February agenda. She has not had an opportunity to visit the requested location.

**3. NEXT MEETING DATE**

The next meeting date of February 14, 2018 was confirmed.

A motion to adjourn was made by R. Keehan, seconded by K. De Cremer. All in favor. Motion carried.
