11. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on both sides of East Shore Drive from a point 385 feet east of East Shore Circle to Nicolet Drive.
12. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a 1-WAY STOP condition on Savage Street at Deer Trail.
