3. Request by Ald. Tim De Wane to remove the NO PARKING signs on the south side of 1100 Lawe Street. **(Ald. De Wane – District 4)**
4. Request by Ald. Zima, on behalf of area residents, to install a NO PARKING HERE TO CORNER sign on the east side of Hazel Street from the driveway at 115 Hazel Street to Christiana Street. **(Ald. Zima – District 9)**

TERMINATION OF TRIAL PERIODS

6. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a NO PARKING zone on the west side of Bornemann Street from a point 185 feet north of Mills Street to a point 140 feet south of Brook Street.
7. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the 15 MINUTE LOADING DELIVERY ONLY zone on the east side of Broadway from a point 180 feet north of Dousman Street to a point 270 feet north of Dousman Street.
8. That, on a 90-day trial, to remove the 2-HOUR PARKING 7 AM TO 7 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY zone on the east side of Broadway from a point 270 feet north of Dousman Street to a point 335 feet north of Dousman Street.
9. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a 2-HOUR PARKING 7 AM TO 7 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY zone on the east side of Broadway from a point 180 feet north of Dousman Street to a point 335 feet north of Dousman Street.
10. That, on a 90-day trial, to establish a 2-HOUR MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY 7 AM TO 7 PM on both sides of Gary Lane from a point 180 feet east of Fellows Drive to its easterly terminus.
