

In light of recent events the Clerk's Office would like to remind residents you can absentee vote by mail.

- 1) First make sure you are registered. Registration through the mail or online ends Wednesday, March 18.
- 2) To request an absentee ballot through the mail send the request to: City Clerk, 100 N Jefferson St. Rm. 106, Green Bay, WI 54301. Include your name, address, phone number and signature. Please provide the address you would like the ballot mailed to if different from your home address. You will need to provide a copy of your photo ID if you are not requesting to be on the indefinitely confined list, are in the military, or are overseas permanently. If you have already voted absentee prior to this election and know you gave us your photo ID you do not have to send it again.
- 3) You may contact the office through email at absenteerequest@greenbaywi.gov. Include your name, address, and phone number. Please provide the address you would like the ballot mailed to if different from your home address. You will need to provide a copy of your photo ID if you are not requesting to be on the indefinitely confined list, are in the military, or are overseas permanently. If you have already voted absentee prior to this election and know you gave us your photo ID you do not have to send it again.

Wednesday, April 1, 8:00 am to 6:30 pm

Thursday, April 2, 8:00 am to 6:30 pm

Friday, April 3, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm (Last day to register and vote in office)
