

The City of Green Bay's Common Council hereby and formally requests an independent investigation by the Wisconsin Elections Commission into the Spring Election held on April 7, 2020.

The City of Green Bay potentially engaged in voter suppression, disenfranchisement and COVID-19 related physical endangerment due to its decisions, actions and inactions relating to the April 7, 2020 election.

In particular, we are requesting the post-investigation report to Green Bay's Common Council would address the following matters:

- 1) Why were citizens volunteering to be poll workers turned away?
- 2) Why were groups volunteering to be poll workers turned away?
- 3) Why was a fully election trained National Guard unit turned away?
- 4) Why utilize only 2 polling locations when social distancing was mandated by the Governor?
- 5) How was absentee ballot request processing addressed?
- 6) Were Federal, State and County officials consulted and their resources fully utilized?
- 7) On the eve of the election, why was the city's social media not updated with voting information, a press release issued and city council members notified of voting location changes instead of a notice regarding Governor Ever's and Mayor Genrich's executive order halting the election?
- 8) Any other pertinent information regarding failures and opportunities.

This independent review will provide the City Council vital information to evaluate, and take corrective action, regarding the city's election shortcomings and assist in creating an action plan to avoid future failures.

Elections Complaints Accepted

Complaints involving the following parties and subjects may be filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission:

- **Local election officials**

A voter may file a complaint alleging that an election official has violated the law or abused the official's discretion regarding nominations, qualifications of candidates, voting qualifications, including residence, ward division and renumbering, recall, ballot preparation, **election administration or conduct of elections**.
