Please do not publicize this information until we provide further guidance. We will send a status update before 12:00 pm today, March 25, 2020.

A Federal District Court ordered that the WEC re-activate online voter registration through March 30 for the April 7 election. Accordingly, as of 7:00 am today, online voter registration (OVR) has been reactivated in MyVote. In addition to OVR, the addressing service that supports the site has been updated to provide improved performance. WEC staff are currently monitoring the site for issues. We will provide an all clear if no significant issues are identified. If we see major issues, we will undo the changes and notify you that OVR will not yet be opened to the public.

We expect to see a surge of traffic to the site when OVR is made public. Just as you are dealing with an unprecedented amount of absentee ballot requests, so are MyVote and WisVote. While we have rigorously tested MyVote's abilities in high traffic scenarios over the past month, periods of peak demand will still challenge the system. As a result, voters and WisVote users may experience some slowness during periods of high volume. WEC staff will continue to monitor election systems around the clock.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to work together through this challenging time.
