I have a couple concerns regarding staffing and layout. I think we can meet the staffing challenge by recruiting city employees into the process, but we need to have that plan in place ASAP. Let Joe or I know what you need to make sure we have a sufficient number of employees committed to the process by the end of the week.

Regarding layout, I'm finding it hard to understand how we can do this in city hall in a way that is safely physically distanced and adequately transparent for the public. By the end of the week, we need a staging plan that has the support of the WEC and both major political parties. This election and the ballot counting process in particular will be highly scrutinized, and we can't afford to have people questioning the integrity of our process. Again, let me know what you need in order to develop a central count plan that has adequate support and trust among the public.

Hello,

Attached is the proposed layout for Central Count.

As of today we have:

28 people from open to close (This include shifts – so two people make up one person)

4 people for the day shift 7 a.m. to 4/5 p.m.

I am waiting for Lisa from PD to let me know who will work

I think a good number to have would be 50 people so lunch, envelope opening, and breaks can be given for the setup that I have attached.

As far as a second shift, I don't feel we need one but I haven't ever been in the situation before either. We will have 7 more teams working than in August. In August everyone was done around 4 p.m. We had 11,596 absentee ballots in August. So far we have 25,240 absentee ballot requests and we have a faster tabulator. The teams I have setup now have between 2500 and 3500 registered voters per team (absentee requests will vary but this should be a good indication of what we could have) and with the faster tabulator which can do 4,000 ballots an hour I think we are fine. Celestine did say Kevin Warych thought he could get 100 PD civilian employees for second shift (I don't know who these people are). Would you like me to see if we can have them on call? I'm don't know physically though if anyone from the Clerk's staff could work from 6 am – through the night. Clerk staff needs to be at City Hall the next day to go through the ward paperwork/Central Count paperwork and get it over to Brown County by 4 p.m. for their canvass.

August 13 teams – 9 hours each – 117 hours total

November 20 teams – 13 hours each – 260 hours total

The other option would be to open up more floors to accommodate more teams. Either way we need more people. I only have people who are City Hall employees, retirees, past employees, or family of City Hall employees. I have been told by some they feel safer this way. My only concern is if we decide to go with more teams, on more floors, Matt Cain and the person from DHS have to know about it Monday, October 19, so they can setup the security plan. I would do pretty much the same on other floors anyway though. Also, would we be able to do more computers for zoom if we go with more floors?

Please let me know your thoughts.

Kris,

Yes, we think you can set up your central count facility this way but you may end up with observers complaining that they can't observe everything going on at once. As you described in your email, you would need observer areas for both areas where ballot processing is taking place and that you will need to be transparent about the process. As long as you can ensure security of document/ballot transfer there should not be a problem transporting ballots from one floor to another. Having chain of custody documentation and multiple inspectors (with inspectors from each party paired up, if possible) are recommended in this situation. The added transparency of the Zoom broadcast is also a good way to allow for observation from the public without having interested parties be present.
