

2019 ADULT FALL SOFTBALL LEAGUE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Resident teams have priority registration beginning June 17th
(Resident teams are defined as teams which include at least 51% residents)
- Open Registration begins July 15-July 22
(Open Registration is defined as teams which include at least 50% or more non-residents)
- **Cancellations:** 50% of the total registration amount paid will be refunded for cancellations 2 weeks or prior to the league start date. No refund will be given within 2 weeks of the league start date. (\$10.00 minimum charge).
- Deadline for all teams is July 22nd at 2:00 p.m.
- We may take additional teams after the deadline if openings exist
- Leagues will play on Tuesday or Thursday evenings
- **Game Cancellation:** Managers will be notified if cancellation is prior to 4:30 p.m. After 4:30 it becomes a Field Call and teams should report to the field at scheduled time.



Depending on the number of teams in each league...

**Leagues Start: Monday, August 19th
or Tuesday, August 20th**

***Schedules will be sent out one week prior to the first game.**

Any new or updated rules will also be submitted at that time. Managers will be responsible for all rules and regulations.

Player Requirements

- All participants must be 18 years or older.
- High School students must be 18 years old and graduating at the end of the current spring semester.
- Students are subject to adult fees.

Resident and non-resident players may be added on-line, over the phone, faxed or by mail, as long as the **\$33.76** non-resident fee accompanies the information. Credit cards now accepted for your convenience. See Rule 1-7 of the Green Bay Athletic League Rules.

- Teams can have a maximum of 16 players registered.
- Teams will not be limited to the number of non-residents.
- Receiving a registration form does not guarantee a spot on the league.



TEAM REGISTRATION FORM - GREEN BAY ADULT FALL SOFTBALL LEAGUE

- The league or sponsor will not be responsible for the expenses incurred due to the injury of any player.
- Player addresses listed below are correct and if they are a non-resident, all appropriate fees will be paid. *Falsification of a player's address will result in that participant being banned from all Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department activities for one year.* Teams will be dropped from the league if they continue to use ineligible players or if they make a mockery of their remaining games.
- Players must be 18 years of age or over. High school students must be 18 years old and graduating at the end of the current spring semester. College varsity or professional players are NOT eligible.
- A player will not play on more than one adult team competing in the softball leagues sponsored by the City of Green Bay on the same evening.
- Players will check all equipment, including uniforms that belong to the sponsor or manager with the sponsor or team manager at the end of the season and understand that if they fail to do so, they will be ineligible to play in any of the City-sponsored sports programs.
- Any team or individuals on a team whose determined ability shows unequal classification may be required to move up or down to the appropriate league as approved by the Administrative Committee.
- Players will pay all expenses of repairing or replacing any publicly owned property that they are responsible for damaging.

All PLAYER INFORMATION MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE TEAM CAN BE REGISTERED.
