Bee in the Loop

A GaGa Ball pit is being installed in Fritsch Park! GaGa Ball consists of a lightweight bouncy or foam ball and an octagon enclosure known as the "GaGa Ball Pit." The object of the game is to hit the ball at or below opponents' knees to eliminate them from the pit. In the rules of GaGa ball, the ball must touch the ground two times before it is considered in play. The last one left in the GaGa Ball Pit is the winner. Games only last a few minutes and eliminated players have the opportunity to re-join again quickly.

This GaGa Ball Pit was made possible through the vision and funding efforts of the Fritsch Park Neighborhood Association and Green Bay Neighborhood Leadership Council.

A large adirondack chair has been installed Navarino Park. This functional art piece has been nicknamed the BBC which is an acronym for Big Blue Chair. The chair will be painted blue next year after the wood has had enough time to dry. There will soon be an expression swing installed in the park too. This swing is designed for a young child and adult caregiver to swing face-to-face. The new additions were made possible through the vision and funding efforts of the Navarino Neighborhood Association, Green Bay Neighborhood Leadership Council, NeighborWorks Green Bay, and Green Bay Public Arts Commission.
