## Election Day Law Enforcement Quick Reference Guide

This pocket reference guide contains key penal provisions found within Chapter 12 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

- Campaigning within 100 feet of a polling place is punishable by a fine up to \$1,000 and 6 months in jail.
- Intimidation of voters is a felony subject to a fine up to \$10,000 and 3 1/2 years in prison.
- Bribery in exchange for a ballot cast is a felony subject to a fine up to \$10,000 and 3 1/2 years in prison.

## Intimidation of Voters (Wis. Stat. § 12.09)

No person may use or threaten to use force, violence, or restraint to compel any person to vote or refrain from voting in any election, or to vote or refrain from voting for a particular candidate or referendum.

Any person violating this prohibition is guilty of a Class 1 felony and shall be punished by imprisonment up to 3 1/2 years, a fine of up to \$10,000, or both.

## Disorderly Behavior (Wis. Stat. § 12.13(3)(x))

No person may refuse to follow a poll worker's lawful order made pursuant to election laws, engage in disorderly behavior at or near a polling place, or interrupt or disturb voting proceedings.

Any person who violates any of these prohibitions may be imprisoned up to 6 months or fined up to \$1,000.

## Election Bribery (Wis. Stat. § 12.11)

No person shall pay or receive any money or anything else of value during an election in order to reward any person for voting or refraining from voting.

Any person violating this prohibition is guilty of a Class 1 felony and shall be punished by imprisonment up to 3 1/2 years, a fine up to \$10,000, or both.

## Electioneering at Polls Prohibited (Wis. Stat. § 12.03)

During polling hours on Election Day, no person may engage in any activity intended to influence voting - such as soliciting votes, placing signs, handing out flyers, etc. - within 100 feet of an entrance to a building containing a polling place.

Any person who violates any of these prohibitions may be imprisoned up to 6 months or fined up to \$1,000.

## Vandalism at Polling Places (Wis. Stat. § 12.13(3)(d))

No person may remove or destroy any of the supplies or conveniences placed in compartments or polling booths on Election Day.

Any person who violates any of these prohibitions may be imprisoned up to 6 months or fined up to \$1,000.

## Tampering with Voting System (Wis. Stat. §§ 12.13(3)(f), (y), (z))

No person may, before or during any election, tamper with voting machines or devices, disable a voting machine to prevent an accurate count of votes, or tamper with automatic tabulating equipment or any computer program used in connection with such equipment to count votes.

Any person violating this prohibition is guilty of a Class 1 felony and shall be punished by imprisonment up to 3 1/2 years, a fine up to \$10,000, or both.
